DIRECTIONS TO BEYOND STABLE FARM

Beyond Stable Farm is conveniently located in Northeastern Illinois minutes from Interstate 90 and easy access from Interstate 94/294.

ARRIVAL Stalls available on Wednesday after 9 AM. **No exceptions.**

All horses on the show grounds must be in good health. Animals showing evidence of contagious or infectious diseases will be removed from the grounds at management or facility discretion. All horses entering the grounds must be able to show proof of a negative coggins within 1 year.

BEDDING

Shavings will be available at \$12 per bag from the show office. No outside bedding allowed. **No fiberboard or stall mats except through Show Time Stall Mats.**

STALLS

Show management will assign stalls on a first come, first served basis. However, stalls will be assigned based on past attendance at IASPHA horse shows. **Barns that attend all three IASPHA shows will be given preferred status on available stalls.** No stalls will be changed without management's approval. Due to the limited number of stalls available, stall reservations will be restricted to a maximum of 20 stalls. Show management has the right to limit the number of tack stalls to provide stalls for horses. **All reserved stalls must be paid for whether used or not.** Stall mats will be available for a fee of \$85.

The judge's decision is FINAL. All classes will be regulated according to IASPHA rules. If not covered by IASPHA, current ESC rules will be followed.

ELECTRICAL APPLIANCE POLICY:

During the summer months, when electrical demand is high, participants agree not to plug in large-scale refrigerators, air conditioner units, or any other high-energy-consuming appliances. To ensure the safety and comfort of the horses, management reserves the right to unplug any devices if the electrical system becomes overloaded. Priority will always be given to maintaining power for essential equipment, such as horse cooling fans. Your cooperation is appreciated in keeping the event safe for all participants and animals.

OVERNIGHT CAMPING

RV Parking spots are available for \$30 per night. This includes 30-amp electrical hookup. **Please reserve on entry form.**

CURRENT IASPHA MEMBERSHIP - January 1-December 31

Exhibitors (defined as owners, riders, and trainers) must be current members of IASPHA.

REFUNDS

No refunds, except for a veterinarian's certificate of unfitness. Only class fees will be refunded. No refunds on stalls ordered.

HORSE SHOW OFFICE TAB

All exhibitors must leave a blank, signed check in the show office before receiving numbers. All checks returned by the bank and having to be resubmitted will be subject to a \$50 fee charged by IASPHA.

HORSE SHOW OFFICE HOURS

The show office will close one hour prior to the start of each session and will reopen at the start of each session. All changes for the upcoming session must be submitted before the office closes.

CLASS SIZE: Recommended class size for under saddle classes in the indoor arena is 8-10 entries, and 6 entries for indoor driving classes. Recommended size for under saddle classes held in the outdoor arena is 15 entries, and 10 entries for outdoor driving classes. Management reserves the right to split any class when safety is a concern.

CONCURRENT CLASSES – Concurrent classes are classes in the ring at the same time but tied separately. The two divisions will not be competing against one another.

WARM-UP RING SAFETY REGULATIONS

To ensure the safest possible event, only participants (riders/drivers, trainers and grooms) are permitted in the warm-up area, preferably, one

class before they compete. Be courteous to novice or young riders, be mindful when changing directions, enter quietly, and avoid blocking the gates. **Abuse of any kind will not be tolerated. If you see a rider, handler, trainer, or anyone else violating the welfare of a horse or rider, report it to management.** We want to create a safe, positive, and fun atmosphere for all to enjoy, and continue to set a good example to all who are watching. **Appropriate warm up ring etiquette will be enforced.**

TWO MINUTE GATE RULE

A two-minute gate rule will be enforced. Notify the horse show office in cases where a gate hold in excess of two minutes is required.

CHAMPIONSHIP ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible to compete in a divisional championship class, a horse or rider must be shown in one other class in that division.

EXHIBITORS AGE

The age of the exhibitor on December 1 will be considered the age for class entry.

DOGS

Dogs must be confined or on a leash. Owner assumes all liability for their dog. Due to safety and liability concerns, all pets in the stabling area must be leashed or contained at all times and crated or contained in a stall/tack room during the horse show performances. **Animals may not block passage in aiseways at any time**

HOLD HARMLESS STATEMENT

Any and all entries in this horse show shall be conditioned upon the following terms and conditions: The IASPHA Horse Show, Illinois American Saddlebred Pleasure Horse Association INC., ESC, Beyond Stable Farm, Illinois Dept. of Agriculture, show management, and sponsors will in no case be responsible for any loss, damage or injury that may occur, and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold them blameless for any loss or injury which may occur by fire, theft or otherwise.

AWARDS AND CLASS SIZE

Classes with less than five entries may be cancelled, combined, or run concurrently. Class splits will be at the discretion of the horse show management. Trophy and 6 ribbons in each regular class. Trophy and 8 ribbons in each Academy class

CHOOSE “A” or “B” SEASON TROPHY POINTS

Exhibitors must declare in advance whether they receive “A” or “B” circuit season trophy points.

WELCOME TO THE BIG TIME

Please notify the horse show office if you were showing in academy classes last year and will be showing in a suit this year.

JUNIOR AND ADULT JUDGING

Judge with the Judge. Judging will take place during the Saturday matinee session. See office for details.

ACADEMY

Academy classes are open to any rider presently enrolled in a professionally operated riding lesson program. Riders must be mounted on school horses. Horses in academy classes may be owned by anyone but they cannot be in training and they **MUST** currently earn their living in a lesson program. Riders may show their own horses in academy provided the horse is regularly used in a professional lesson program. Academy horses may be shown by non-academy riders in any other classes in the show for which they are eligible. The age of riders is as of December 1. **All academy riders must be entered by the entry date deadline so splits may be determined if necessary.**

ACADEMY ENTRIES: If academy entries are being completed on Horse Shows Online, please enter each academy rider separately (on their own entry form). A horse may be entered multiple times, and this will ensure each academy rider will have their own back number.

GREEN RIDER: Green Rider is defined as an academy rider in their first calendar year of showing (January-December). Riders showing in Green Rider may not cross enter into regular academy classes at the same show. Once a rider shows in a regular academy class at a show (if Green classes are offered), they are no longer eligible for Green Rider classes.

LIMIT RIDER: Limit Rider is defined as an academy rider that has not won 6 blue ribbons in the academy division (excluding leadline). Riders showing in Limit Rider may not cross enter into regular academy classes at the same show.

ATTIRE: Jodhpurs or dark pants, a collared white or colored long sleeve shirt, tie, jodhpur boots or sturdy shoes. Sweater vest, sweater or fitted vest permitted; no habits or hats. Helmets are strongly recommended and are required for 10 and under riders.

ASTM/SEI Approved Equine Helmet: Helmets are required in all 10 & Under Academy Walk-Trot classes.

EQUIPMENT: Normal academy equipment (i.e., Martingales, snaffles, etc.) permitted in walk-trot and walk-trot-canter classes. Wraps, shin boots, bell boots and blinkers are permitted.

LEAD LINE WALK/TROT: Riders will be led in at a walk and worked each way of the ring. The riders will be individually trotted past the judge. Riders are expected to post, but correct diagonals are not required. Class will be judged.

ACADEMY HORSEMANSHIP: Will be judged on the horse's manners and suitability. **Horsemanship is paramount.** Diagonals will not count. The overall appearance of any pleasure horse should depict a horse that enjoys what he is doing.

Walk-trot riders may only enter walk-trot equitation and/or walk-trot pleasure classes. Walk-trot-canter riders may only enter walk-trot-canter equitation and/or walk-trot-canter horsemanship classes. Riders entered in green rider classes may only enter green rider classes in that division. Riders may not cross-enter.

PATTERN CLASSES: Pattern classes are to be run where a rider/horse enters the ring one rider at a time and executes a specific pattern posted a minimum of one hour before the class. No rail work. Judged on the combination of the rider's skill of controlling the horse, accuracy of the pattern, and the rider's equitation. Horses may be shared. No backing will be asked for in the pattern. Recommended splitting at 12-15 entries.

HORSEMANSHIP/EQUITATION CHAMPIONSHIPS: Exhibitors must have been entered, shown, and judged in their qualifying class to be eligible to enter their respective championship. It is recommended that a minimum of four riders be asked to perform an individual workout in Academy Equitation Championships, and workouts must be chosen from the list below.

CHAMPIONSHIP WORKOUTS: Walk and Trot: Workouts 1 thru 3.
Walk/Trot/Canter: Workouts 2 thru 8.

1. Stand up in posting position – hold position until judge says to sit. Hands may be on saddle.
2. The judge can ask some riders to go back to the rail and do a workout around the ring at a walk-trot, reverse walk-trot, etc. and return to lineup.
3. Trot a straightaway showing a change of diagonals; rider must start on correct diagonal.
4. Trot down straightaway to end, stop, reverse and canter back.
5. On a straightaway, trot half way on the correct diagonal, stop, and canter the remaining distance on the correct lead.
6. Trot a figure eight or trot a serpentine.
7. Canter down straightaway, stop, then ride a circle at a trot.
8. Trot down straightaway, stop, and canter a circle.

ACADEMY DRIVING: A Pleasure Driving class in which entries are judged primarily on the ability and skill of the driver to manage the horse or pony in the ring. To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk and trot. Manners to be judged. Drivers are encouraged to have an instructor in the cart for safety.

SINGLE-BIT DIVISION

Single Bit classes are open to Amateur or Juvenile riders in a snaffle bit only (no curb bits or curb chains allowed), with a running martingale, German martingale or draw rein. All tack should be of show ring quality. Riders are to wear appropriate show ring attire. Horse/rider combinations may not cross enter into another division, with the exception of the Model, Showmanship and Pattern classes, unless otherwise stated in the prize list. The same horse/rider combination may not compete in both the W/T and the W/T/C sections of the Single Bit division at the same horse show.

EQUINE SPORTS COUNCIL

The IASPCHA Horse Show Series is governed by the Equine Sports Council. The Equine Sports Council provides rules and standards, marketing, support, and education to their network of horse shows with an emphasis on integrity, sportsmanship and safety.
